This is the first printmaking exhibition the Jubilee Gallery has mounted since opening in 2004. Selected by Michael Honnor, painter, printmaker and Member of the Devon Guild, and Richard Anderton, MA Printmaking course leader at the University of the West of England, this exhibition brings together a group of makers working in a range of printmaking techniques.

Printmaking is a highly skilful process and *Up close* shows work that is imaginative and precise. Working in processes such as etching, lino cutting, wood cutting, lithography, engraving, monoprinting and screenprinting, each exhibitor has worked to the same parameters of frame size and has experimented within this prescribed size to produce exciting and widely varying works allowing visitors to get *Up close* to handmade printmaking.
