The Devon Guild is an educational charity and membership organisation which seeks to inspire excellence in contemporary craft. With a nationally respected reputation and being the regional development agency for the crafts in the South West, the Devon Guild promotes the highest standards of craftsmanship and design. The Membership currently has 250 Full and 40 Associate Members and a Student Membership scheme to support makers during their studies and at a very early stage in their careers. The work of Full and Associate Members is selected against the Devon Guild's membership criteria, while Student Membership is not selected. To foster their career aspirations, the student scheme will inform students about what it means to be a professional maker and let students gain insight into the working practices of a professional craft organisation.

Student Membership is £20 per annum and benefits for Student Membership include:

- opportunity for inclusion in the regular e-newsletter and printed newsletter
- connecting with full-time professional makers through networking opportunities
- free or discounted lectures and seminars from visiting and local makers
- advice and support relating to funding, craft fairs and marketing
- access to professional development and practical training courses
- support and expertise of fellow Members and the Guild's staff
- networking opportunities for mutual support, including invitations to Private Views and Members' meetings
- opportunities to be actively involved and gain first hand work experience through volunteering (e.g. shop or exhibitions work)
